Slip – Trip – Fall	• Court surface must be in good condition, free of obstruction & loose objects • Equipment left inside the fence that poses a danger to people must be removed • Net & supports must be in good condition	Possible	Minor	Satisfactory
Structure Failure	• Inspection of the tennis court area is completed by site staff before each group arrives • If any part of the tennis court area is unsafe it is to be closed off until appropriate action has been taken	Rare	Moderate	Satisfactory
Equipment Failure	• Inspection of Tennis Rackets and Balls is completed by site staff before each group arrives • If any piece of equipment is deemed unsafe it is to be removed, repaired or replaced.	Rare	Moderate	Satisfactory
Injury to spectators	• Spectators & non-participating players are to instructed to remain outside the court area during play	Possible	Minor	Satisfactory
